- Cumulative GPA 2.5 or above.
- Graduating High School Senior
- Involved in school, church, and community activities. Included all volunteer hours. Include work experience.
- Write a 200- to 300-word essay on the topic "What my career goals are and how I see my post secondary education helping me to achieve these goals."
(Essay must be typed and double spaced.)
